### [Ebico teams up with LHA-ASRA Housing Group to combat fuel poverty](#)

Ebico is pleased to announce we've teamed up with LHA-ASRA housing group to offer customers from the East Midlands and London fairer gas and electricity prices to heat and power their homes. It is estimated that around 21% of the people in the East Midlands and 13% in London now live in Fuel Poverty.

The agreement will see residents in these regions being able to take advantage of Ebico's specially designed tariff that has no standing charge and just one flat rate per unit of energy used, this enables customers to take greater control of their energy bills.
